

MILWAUKEE NUMISMATIC SOCIETY ANA SUMMER SEMINAR SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Milwaukee Numismatic Society is pleased to make available to its members up to 3 scholarships to the ANA Summer Seminar each year.

One of these is referred to as a 'full' scholarship, consisting of the ANA's base registration fee (covering tuition, room and board at Colorado College) and transportation to and from the seminar. The award is currently established at \$1,075 (estimated) plus transportation. The recipient must contact the ANA to register for the Summer Seminar.

The other two scholarships are referred to as 'partial' scholarships, and consist of the ANA's base registration fee for tuition, room and board only. Transportation is at your expense. This (currently) is a double room in Loomis Hall on the Colorado College campus. The current amount of these scholarships (for 2016) is estimated to be approximately \$1,075.

These scholarships cover the cost of the ANA Member basic fee. Any surcharge for non-ANA member is the responsibility of the recipient. Non-ANA members should apply for ANA membership, as that is usually less than the non-member surcharge.

Not covered in any scholarship are:

- ANA non-member surcharge
- Upgrades to rooms
- Mini-Seminars (usually held in the evenings)
- Off-campus tours and other events (such as the Flying W Ranch)
- Extra night charges at either end of the seminar.

Additionally not covered in the partial scholarships is:

- Transportation

Junior members between the ages of 14 and 17 years are encouraged to apply. We're sorry, applications from members under age 14 will not be accepted. If the applicant is under 18 years of age, the application must be signed by a parent or guardian. Scholarship winners under 18 years of age are required to travel with an adult parent or guardian. Said adult will travel at no cost to the Milwaukee Numismatic Society.

All recipients are expected to give a report, written or oral, about the seminar in general, and the course they took in particular, soon after returning.

The qualifying period is the calendar year preceding the Seminar. Applications must be sent to the committee prior to February 1 of the year of the Seminar.

The scholarship is intended to be used for the year for which it was awarded.

The Selection Committee is authorized to deal with questions or circumstances not covered in the published rules.
