The two scholarships are referred to as 'partial' scholarships, and consist of a \$1,000 grant for each scholarship.

Junior members between the ages of 14 and 17 years are encouraged to apply. We're sorry, applications from members under age 14 will not be accepted. If the applicant is under 18 years of age, the application must be signed by a parent or guardian. Scholarship winners under 18 years of age are required to travel with an adult parent or guardian. Said adult will travel at no cost to the Milwaukee Numismatic Society.

All recipients are expected to give a report, written or oral, about the seminar in general, and the course they took in particular, soon after returning.

The qualifying period is the calendar year preceding the Seminar. Applications must be received by the committee prior to February 1 of the year of the Seminar.

The scholarship is intended to be used for the year for which it was awarded.

The Selection Committee is authorized to deal with questions or circumstances not covered in the published rules.
